

# Official Rules

Please read these Contest Rules in their entirety before entering the Contest. Do not enter the Contest unless you agree to these Contest Rules. Participation in the Contest constitutes unconditional agreement and acceptance to these Contest Rules which are final on all matters relating to the Contest.

## CONTEST PERIOD

The Contest begins on December 2, 2011 at 12:01 p.m.. (NST) and ends on January 5, 2012 at 11:59 p.m. (NST) (the “Contest Period”)

## ELIGIBILITY

The Contest is conducted by Conservation Corps Newfoundland and Labrador and is open to all Facebook users who have reached the age of thirteen (13).

Entrants are not eligible to participate in the Contest if they are current employees and/or volunteer board members, or a member of the household and/or immediate family of any of the aforementioned parties (for the purpose of the Contest Rules, “immediate family” means spouse or reside in the same household).

Conservation Corps Newfoundland and Labrador shall have the right at any time to require proof of identity and/or eligibility to claim the Prize. Failure to provide such proof within a reasonable period of time may result in disqualification. All personal and other information requested by and supplied to Conservation Corps Newfoundland and Labrador for the purpose of this Contest must be truthful, complete, accurate, and in no way misleading. Conservation Corps Newfoundland and Labrador reserves the right to disqualify any entrant in its sole discretion should any entrant at any stage contain and/or supply untruthful, incomplete, inaccurate or misleading personal details and/or information.

## HOW TO ENTER

To enter, click the contest Tab on the Conservation Corps Newfoundland and Labrador Facebook page to fill out the ballot to automatically receive one (1) entry into the Contest. Contest content is only accessible to individuals who “Like” the Conservation Corps Newfoundland and Labrador Facebook. Each participant is entitled to one (1) entry. Duplicate entries will not be considered.

## PRIZE

There will be one (1) single prize available to be won, consisting of one (1) Apple iPad 2 (White, 32GB, Wifi + 3G) with decorative plastic skin. Estimated value of prize is \$772.95 plus applicable sales tax.

The Prize must be accepted as awarded and cannot be substituted or redeemed for cash.

## PRIZE DRAW

The Prize will be drawn randomly from among all eligible entries received during the Contest Period. The drawing will be held on January 6<sup>th</sup>, 2012 after the Contest Period has ended. The odds of winning will depend on the number of eligible entries received during the Contest Period.

Verifications will be made before a selected person is declared a winner. Additionally, the winner must comply with the terms of these Contest Rules.

The winner will be notified via email through the Contest Application (hereto referred to as "Sweepstakes Applet") or by representative of Conservation Corps Newfoundland and Labrador. Prize may only be claimed by the person registered for the Contest. Winner of the contest must contact Conservation Corps Newfoundland and Labrador via telephone or email ([communications@ccnl.ca](mailto:communications@ccnl.ca)) within two (2) weeks of January 6<sup>th</sup>, 2012.

If the selected person does not contact Conservation Corps Newfoundland and Labrador within two weeks following the draw, they shall be disqualified and another drawing will be held for the Prize, in accordance with the Contest Rules, until an entrant is selected and declared the Prize winner. In such a case, the same terms and conditions will remain applicable and will be adapted as necessary. Conservation Corps Newfoundland and Labrador is not responsible for a selected eligible entrant's failure to receive notification for any reason whatsoever.
