POSITION DESCRIPTION: As part of the Conservation Corps of NL's Waterford Watershed Research, Restoration, and Outreach Program, a full assessment of the current health of the Waterford watershed will be completed. The successful candidate for this position will assist the Watershed Conservation Coordinator in performing field assessments on the health of the Waterford watershed, entering data using excel, report writing, and creating and disseminating education and outreach materials on watersheds and their benefits. *Successful applicants will be required to participate in Occupational Health and Safety (OH&S) training and follow all OH&S regulations as well as all other policies of CCNL.*
